About eCampusOntario

eCampusOntario is a not-for-profit organization that accelerates the transformation of postsecondary digital learning in Ontario to increase participation in higher education. The organization leads a consortium of the province's publicly assisted colleges, universities and Indigenous institutes to advance the development and adoption of online and digital learning technologies, programs and environments.

The Opportunity

Last year, eCampusOntario established a Francophone Advisory Network (FAN) to guide the expansion of Francophone and French as a Second Language virtual learning materials and programming in the province.

We are seeking **1 new** volunteer committee member with the expertise to provide insights into the exciting initiatives eCampusOntario is taking this year to advance francophone technology-enabled learning.

FAN will be a framework for cohesion, consultation, resource pooling, sharing and development between French, bilingual and English language institutions engaged in work to advance francophone activities and interests. FAN will focus on enhancing digital solutions to help graduate Francophone learners with the important skills that prepare them for a meaningful future.

FAN will support and advise eCampusOntario on:

- The cultivation of the francophone and FSL community in postsecondary education
- The professional development (PD) of postsecondary educators in digital teaching and learning as well as learning (PD) resources

- The curation and uptake of FL and FSL teaching and learning resources and solutions available in the eCampusOntario Open Library and across institutions
- The design, implementation and growth of Communities of Practice (involving insights and recommendations about the strategies for CoPs and identifying issues of concern as moderator between the CoPs and eCampusOntario)
- The sustainability of the CoPs for the Francophone and FSL community in postsecondary education

Meetings will be conducted in French and take place virtually. Approximately four meetings are anticipated. The inaugural meeting will be scheduled for the summer of 2024.
