Expression of Interest (EOI)

Background: Teaching with AI Micro-credential

Teaching with AI / Enseigner avec l'IA is a bilingual (English/French) facilitated microcredential program designed to help postsecondary educators and future teachers develop key skills in exploring, evaluating, and experimenting with AI and Generative AI in their teaching practices.

By the end of this micro-credential, learners will have the capacity to:

- Discern the key concepts and contexts of AI
- Demonstrate practical and ethical AI integration strategies in educational contexts
- Integrate AI effectively into teaching and learning practices
- Recommend strategies for AI-enabled education.

Opportunity

eCampusOntario is accepting expressions of interest (EOI) for **Teaching with AI Champions** from Ontario's publicly-assisted Indigenous institutions, colleges and universities, **to provide feedback** during the development phases of the micro-credential. The development phase started on August 25, 2025, and will end on January 14, 2026.

These **Champions** will hold positions within educational departments as faculty or support staff and must be AI leaders in their institution. If you are an **AI Champion** and interested in enhancing the Teaching with AI Micro-credential, we invite you to participate to the **Teaching with AI Champions** program. Champions will participate in reviewing and providing feedback on the program in EN or FR only, not both official languages.

Applicant Responsibilities

Teaching with AI **Champion** applicants will be responsible for:

- Providing feedback during the development phase of the program. (Timeline below)
- Completing a feedback questionnaire within a given timeline (2-3 days).
- Meeting with eCampusOntario staff if necessary.

This EOI will be awarded as per the specified application guidelines. Up to 10 **Teaching with AI Champions** will be selected. No more than one Champion will be appointed within each institution, and we will prioritize minimum 1 from Francophone Institution, Indigenous Institute, College, and University in awarding the opportunities.

Financial Support

Each **Teaching with AI Champion** will receive a stipend of \$2,000.

Application Guidelines

The application must include:

1. Applicant Details
 - a. Applicant's position
 - b. Applicant's contact information
 - c. Name of the institution
 - d. Name of the educational department
2. Applicant Profile
 - a. Explain why you are wanting to participate in this program as a Champion.
 - b. Explain why you believe Teaching with AI is important for educators and future teachers and include summary of your past projects for AI on an institution campus.

Teaching with AI Eligibility

- Employed within an educational department as faculty (including contract faculty) or support staff at an Ontario publicly-assisted Indigenous institution, college or university
- Application Submission Requirements
 - No late submissions will be accepted
 - Email submissions only
 - Be sure to complete the submission in its entirety
- Demonstrate a commitment to complete the required tasks

Technical Requirements

As a Teaching with AI, ensuring all participating parties have reliable access to:

- A computer
- A high-speed Internet connection
- A professional/personal Microsoft Teams account

Participation

As a Teaching with AI Champion you will:

- Agree to the applicant responsibilities
- Follow the application guidelines and submit a complete application
- Agree to complete the required tasks
- Agree to the expectations set forth in the timeline
- Meet the eligibility criteria
- Meet the technical requirements for participation
- Provide consent through an eCampusOntario provided media release to be profiled as a Teaching with AI Champion on the eCampusOntario website/social media channels
