

# Micro-Credential Summit 2026 Travel Bursary Application

eCampusOntario is allocating funds for faculty, staff, and administrators of its member institutions to travel and attend Micro-Credential Summit 2026: Tomorrow's Skills, taking place in person at The Quay (Toronto, ON) on February 11–12, 2026.

#### THE OPPORTUNITY

Recipients will be awarded a **\$500 travel bursary** to support their attendance at **Micro-Credential Summit 2026**. This bursary is intended to help cover eligible travel-related expenses such as accommodations, parking, meals, gas, and transportation.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- To qualify, the recipient must:
- Work at a publicly-assisted Indigenous Institute, college, or university in Ontario
- Reside more than **200 kilometers (one-way)** from the site of **Micro-Credential Summit 2026 (The Quay, Toronto)**.
- Apply in advance of attending MCS 2026.

Applications will remain open until 11:59 pm ET on Feb. 4, 2026, or until available funds are exhausted. Don't wait – apply today!

### **PROCESS & TIMELINES**

Applicants will receive an email confirming the status of their application within one week of completing the form.

Upon attending **Micro-Credential Summit 2026**, bursary recipients will be required to **sign an attendance confirmation form** at the conference registration desk.



Within **five business days** of the event, recipients will receive **banking forms** to complete and return to eCampusOntario for bursary payment. Recipients can expect to receive funds **within three weeks** of eCampusOntario receiving completed forms.

eCampusOntario will issue a **T4A for the 2026 tax year** to all recipients in accordance with CRA guidelines. As receipts will not be collected, it is the recipient's responsibility to retain all documentation for personal tax purposes.
